CENTRE EXTENDS ALMM FRAMEWORK TO INGOTS, WAFERS

Solar sourcing rule to lower imports effective from 2028

New Delhi, March 18

IN A MAJOR policy shift aimed at curbing import dependence, the government on Wednesday mandated that all solar projects use locally manufactured ingots and wafers from June 1, 2028, extending domestic sourcing rules to the most import-dependent segment of the solar supply chain.

The move, notified by the ministry of new and renewable energy (MNRE), expands the Approved List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM) framework beyond modules and cells to upstream components, where India remains heavily reliant on imports, largely from China. Solar panels are made up of modules that contain cells. Cell manufacturing depends on ingots, which in turn require wafers. India currently has around 2 GW of ingot and wafer manufacturing capacity, even as solar deployment continues to accelerate. The new mandate will apply across utility-scale, open access and net-metering projects, with future bids required to comply.

LOCAL PUSH

- Rule to cover utility-scale, open access and rooftop projects, with future bids required to comply
- Domestic ingot-wafer capacity at about 2 GW, far below rising solar deployment needs
- Eligibility conditional on at least 3 firms jointly commissioning 15 GW capacity to avoid supply shocks

To avoid supply disruption, the government will notify eligible manufacturers only after at least three independent players with a combined capacity of 15 GW are operational. Companies will also be required to have integrated manufacturing capability across ingots and wafers, pushing the sector towards scale and vertical integration.

Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy Pralhad Joshi said the decision aims to deepen domestic manufacturing. "The move will boost domestic production, enhance supply chain resilience, reduce import dependence, and ensure higher quality standards across the solar value chain," he said.

Prashant Mathur, CEO of Saatvik Green Energy, said the decision reinforces India's intent to control its supply chain. "This is a bold affirmation that India is determined to own its solar supply chain, cut imports dependencies, and generate jobs at scale," he said. However, industry bodies flagged the scale of investment required.

Scindia: 6G to drive next leap in human civilisation

THE DEVELOPMENT OF sixth-generation (6G) telecom technologies will rest on four pillars—global interoperability, a common technical framework, accelerated innovation and inclusive growth—Union Communications Minister Jyotirajya Scindia said on Wednesday.

Addressing an international workshop on 6G standardisation, the minister described the upcoming technology as the next leap in human civilisation. He underlined that seamless interoperability across devices, networks and services would be critical to building a unified global communications ecosystem. "Our decisive role has to be based on four key pillars. First to ensure global interoperability between devices, networks and services. And this has to be the case across the world so the world communicates seamlessly across a global unified communication ecosystem," he said, adding that the Bharat 6G Alliance would anchor India's participation in the global standard-setting process.

House panel for upward revision of wage floor

RISING COSTS

A PARLIAMENTARY STANDING Committee has urged the ministry of labour and employment to raise the National Floor Level Minimum Wage (NFLMW) without any further delay. The floor levels have remained unchanged for several years and no longer reflects current living costs, inflationary pressures, or the essential needs of workers and their families across India, the panel highlighted.

It said the lack of revision erodes real wages and fails to safeguard vulnerable workers, particularly those employed in the informal sector. In its recent report, the committee highlighted that the NFLMW serves as the foundational benchmark for setting minimum wages in various sectors and regions nationwide. The government revised NFLMW in June 2017 to ₹176 per day from ₹160 per day, fixed in 2015. The NFLMW per day in 1996 was ₹35 per day. Under the Code on Wages, 2019, the statutory floor wages intended to provide a baseline for income security, especially for those in the unorganised sector. However, the prolonged

stagnation of the NFLMW prevents meaningful regular increases in minimum wages, thereby weakening efforts to ensure dignity of labour and promote balanced economic growth, the committee noted. The panel called for an immediate, comprehensive review and upward adjustment of the NFLMW, drawing on the most recent Consumer Price Index data, nutritional standards, housing costs, education expenses, healthcare requirements, and other vital living expenditures. The process should rely on transparent, evidence-based criteria and involve broad consultations with workers' representatives, employers, state governments, and all relevant stakeholders.

Furthermore, the committee recommended establishing a formal mechanism for regular and automatic periodic revisions of the floor wage to shield it from inflation-driven erosion and maintain its relevance over time. It asked the ministry to provide a clear timeline for the revision within three months of the report's presentation. The committee also noted that while states are required to set their minimum wages at or above the notified national floor level, in certain instances the minimum wages fixed by some states tend to remain "close to or, in effect, fall below the notified floor wage when adjustments across different categories and employment are considered."

'NITI to back city growth plans'

NITI AAYOG WILL support the preparation of integrated development plans for 20 city regions, as India sharpens its focus on urban-led growth, its member Rajiv Gauba said on Wednesday. Over the past decade, the Centre has significantly expanded its urban push through flagship programmes such as the Smart Cities Mission, AMRUT, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban, and

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban. Budgetary allocations for the urban sector have risen nearly tenfold, enabling the construction of around 10 million houses, with another 10 million already sanctioned, Gauba said at the Urban Conclave 2024 of Jaanaagrah. Massive investments—estimated at ₹3.5 lakh crore—have also been directed towards metro rail, bus rapid transit systems, and regional rapid rail networks. These efforts come at a time when India is undergoing

a major demographic transition, with cities expected to play a decisive role in achieving the country's ambition of becoming a developed nation by 2047. To unlock this potential, NITI Aayog launched the Growth Hub for City Regions initiative, encouraging states to adopt a regional and economically driven approach to urban planning. "Surat, Mumbai and Varanasi have prepared their plans under this initiative, and NITI would be supporting the development," Gauba said.

IRFC's ₹70,000 cr fundraising aims to beat G-Sec rate

New Delhi, March 18

INDIAN RAILWAY FINANCE CORPORATION (IRFC), which has lined up a massive fundraising plan of ₹70,000 crore for FY27, will seek to keep its cost of borrowing below the G-sec rates, said its Chairman and Managing Director Manoj Kumar Dubey on Wednesday.

The funds will help meet the requirements of Indian Railways, disbursement for diversification under the IRFC 2.0 plan, besides addressing committed liabilities and refinancing existing loans.

"For infrastructure projects, the most important raw material is cheap finance. By having access to the cheapest finance, everything can be built up in a smart way," Dubey told FE. Broadly, IRFC's borrowing mix includes 50% bonds, 25% external commercial borrowings (ECBs) and 25% term loans.

The yield on benchmark 10-year G-Sec edged up to 6.73% on Wednesday. For FY26, the PSU had set a target to raise ₹60,000 crore, with an disbursement plan of ₹30,000 crore. "The remaining amount goes into refinancing where the company do cost optimisation by replacing higher cost borrowings with cheaper options, Dubey said. "Nearly 50-60% of total borrowing goes to the real disbursement, and 40% goes to internal adjustments," Dubey said on the sidelines of FICCI Infrastructure Conclave 2026. A recent case point is IRFC executing a ₹9,821-crore loan agreement to refinance the Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India's (DFCCIL's) existing foreign currency debt with the World Bank. This move allowed DFCCIL to save an estimated ₹2,700 in interest costs over the loan tenure while also replacing forex exposure with IRFC's rupee financing. IRFC has substantially increased its lending over the

past two years as it has pivoted from being dependent on a single client (Indian Railways) for nearly 38 years to a multi-client system lending to sectors – power, ports and renewable energy, logistics – which have forward and backward linkages to the railways. Diversification has also resulted in better margins for IRFC because in case of traditional lending to the Ministry of Railways, which is considered safe, the company earns a margin of 35-40 basis points (bps) over its cost of funds. In non-railway lending, this margin goes up to over 100 bps.

"If we are lending ₹30,000 crore to the broader ecosystem, they'd be akin to lending ₹1 lakh crore to the railways. That's the whole game," Dubey said. IRFC is now looking at funding the roads sector, especially projects worth over ₹2,000 crore. "We have already crossed the lending target for FY26. The cumulative sanctions have crossed ₹80,000 crore for the current fiscal. These are projects where we have signed the agreements and the borrowers typically have three years to use this sanctioned amount. Now, we are taking a good look at the road sector," Dubey said.

बुधवार को 999 च्युरीटी वाली चांदी का भाव 2,49,907 रुपए प्रति किलोग्राम रहा, जिसकी कीमत बीते मंगलवार को 2,52,340 रुपए प्रति किलोग्राम थी। यानी एक दिन में चांदी की कीमत 2,433 रुपए प्रति किलो कम हो गई।
